Research is performed at university in interdisciplinary cooperation or in cooperation with industry. Alongside the successful participation in the excellence initiative and three of the Collaborative Research Centres funded by the German Research Foundation (DFG) the WHO Collaborating Center for Research and Training in Veterinary Public Health as well as the EU-Reference Laboratory for European Classical Swine Fever and other Pestiviruses should be mentioned.

Internationally the TiHo fosters numerous contacts. At present there are partnerships and cooperations with 30 foreign universities and veterinary medical faculties in 23 countries.
